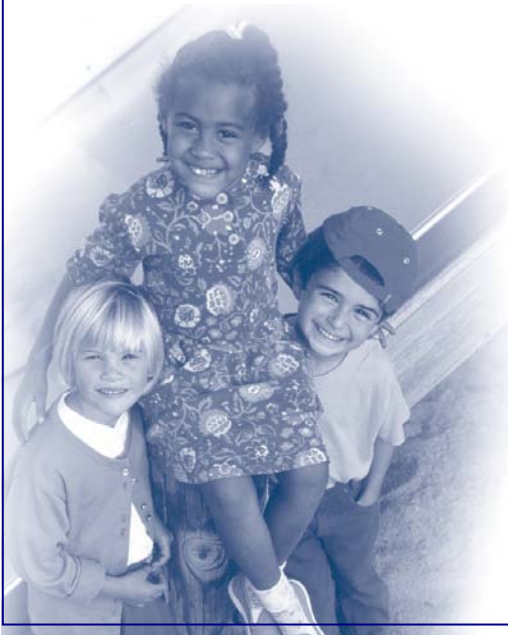

CLUB STRUCTURE

- ✚ Though there are no attendance requirements, members are encouraged to attend meetings on a regular basis and to participate in club service projects
- ✚ One-time membership fee of \$50. Annual dues are \$300 (\$162.50 semi-annually). Annual billing is done in October. Dues include the cost of member's meals for all club meetings, including the spring picnic and Christmas dinner. The club record and financial year is October 1st to September 30th.
- ✚ You receive a mailed or e-mailed club newsletter one week before each meeting, the Carolinas District quarterly newsletter, *The Carolina Kiwanian*, and *Kiwanis*, the national magazine.
